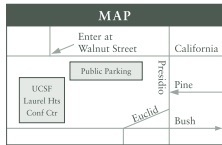

## DANIELLE & JEAN-MICHEL QUINODOZ

## PROGRAM

## REGISTRATION

DANIELLE QUINODOZ has coined the term “heterogeneous” to refer to a patient who has both neurotic and psychotic elements. Her book *Words that Touch: A Psychoanalyst Learns to Speak* describes how she works with such patient whom she believe analysts are most likely to treat in the 21st century. Consulting with a patient who angrily declares that analysis is “just words” Ms. Quinodoz comes to realize that words alone are not enough to really reach her. Ms. Quinodoz uses the music and syntax of her speech, “words that touch” to reach preverbal, primitive aspects. A thoughtful and compassionate clinician, Ms. Quinodoz is flexible in her technique and demonstrates how a clinician can evolve to meet the needs of the real people who walk through our doors.

Danielle Quinodoz is a Training Analyst at the Swiss Psychoanalytic Society. In addition to papers published in French and English-language journals (such as the *International Journal of Psychoanalysis*), she is author of *Emotional Vertigo: Between Anxiety and Pleasure* (which received the Prix Psychologie 1995) and *Words that Touch*. She received the Sacerdoti Prize in 1989.

JEAN-MICHEL QUINODOZ has worked extensively with Hanna Segal and has a forthcoming book on her work: *Listening to Hanna Segal: Her Contributions to Psychoanalysis*. He is known as integrative thinker drawing from the ideas of Freud, Klein, Fairbairn, Winnicott, Anna Freud, Mahler, Kohut and Bowlby in addition to Segal. He has a gift for taking a concept that is familiar and seeing it in a fresh and interesting way. For example, in his book *The Taming of Solitude: Separation Anxiety in Psychoanalysis*, he draws our attention to how separation anxiety is always with us in one form or another. Yet he argues that it is in solitude that one comes to know the uniqueness of oneself and of others.

Jean-Michel Quinodoz is a Training and Supervising Analyst of the Swiss Psychoanalytical Society. He was the Editor for Europe of the *International Journal of Psychoanalysis* (1993-2003). In addition to numerous papers and the previously mentioned books, he is author of *Dreams That Turn Over a Page* and *Reading Freud: A Chronological Exploration of Freud’s Writing*.
